

## **JT Travel SIM Card – Terms of Reference**

Use of the JT Travel SIM Card is governed by the JT Post-Paid Mobile Telephone Service terms and conditions and the JT Website terms and conditions. In addition, the following Terms of Reference apply:

1. The daily credit limit for calls, SMS and data transmitted using the JT Travel SIM Card (the “Service”) is £50. If this limit is exceeded the Service will be disconnected and you will be required to call 154 for reconnection on the same day. JT will reconnect the Service on the same day at its sole discretion. If you are disconnected for exceeding the credit limit and do not request reconnection on the same day, JT will automatically reconnect the Service on the next day (one day being the period of 24 hours in the UTC time zone).
2. If the Service is not used for more than 18 months, JT will deactivate the JT Travel SIM Card. Continued use of the Service after deactivation will require purchase of a new JT Travel SIM Card.
3. When roaming in the +1 Dialling Code Area (USA and Canada), a +1 US local number will be allocated to the JT Travel SIM Card. If this +1 US local number is not used for more than two months, JT will deactivate the number. If you try to use the Service in the +1 Dialling Code Area after deactivation of the +1 US local number, you will automatically receive a new +1 US local number and you will be informed of the new number by text message.
4. Online billing and payment by Direct Debit are mandatory for use of the JT Travel SIM Card. For billing or payment made by other methods JT will make an additional charge of £1.25 each month. Therefore if you do not sign up to both online billing and payment by Direct Debit, JT will charge you an additional total amount of £2.50 per month.
5. Application for a JT Travel SIM Card requires proof of residency in Jersey for the past one year.
6. A JT Travel SIM Card is non-transferable.
7. You agree that JT has the right, but not the obligation, to monitor usage of the Service, and may communicate security issues to you when abuse or misuse is observed or reported by others.
